14 The Lake County District Attorney’s Office will require the following waiver from a Defendant  
15 in a criminal proceeding prior to acceptance of a negotiated felony plea agreement:

16 “I hereby waive my rights under *Apprendi* and *Blakely* to jury findings and allow the  
17 court to consider aggravating and mitigating factors for sentencing. I further waive my  
18 right under *Apprendi* and *Blakely* to jury findings as to counts dismissed with a *Harvey*  
19 waiver and allow the court to consider dismissed counts for purposes of sentencing.”
